1. Introductions

2. Strategic Plan

- a. Group reviewed New Dashboard spreadsheet and identified initiatives that are still in progress.
 - i. The HUD-driven initiative of becoming a Unified Funding Agency may be removed if it's no longer being pursued.
- b. Group will look at Blueprint to tie it in with the strategic plan.
 - i. Many of the Blueprint initiatives may be led by the Alliance including bringing funding resources into the community.

3. Engagement & Structure

- a. How we want to be engaged through SPFAC; explore restricting possibilities and interests.
 - Group would like to continue to meet monthly, possibly in small workgroups; review info if needed between meetings with working meetings monthly or every other month.
 - ii. Group to outreach/invite participants from other agencies to engage.
 - 1. OLHSA & Pontiac Housing Commission have been invited.
 - 2. HAVEN, CNS, Affirmations, & Easterseals suggested to be invited.
 - 3. Those who can offer assistance in communication would benefit the group.

4. Advocacy and Public Awareness

- a. Advocacy needed around basic needs.
 - Charlie Cavell is working on accessing ARPA funds for basic needs, rental/utility assistance. Others are advocating for funding as well.
 - 1. Invite conversation with Charlie to inform the urgency of need
 - ii. Coordinate efforts of communication between agencies and advocate for underserved populations.
 - iii. Alliance can lead unified messaging.
- b. November is Homeless Awareness Month



5. PR Portion

- a. Point in Time Count is on January 25th, 2023

 - ii. We are also looking for donations for the care kits that we pass out to unsheltered folks - things like hygiene items, and winter gear (hats, gloves, hand warmers).
 - iii. Ashley will create a post for agencies to share and spread the word.

6. Strategic Plan & Funding

- a. SPM Return to Homelessness/Short-term hotel stays
 - Gap for individuals housed with PSH who need support with a mental health crisis or emergencies like a flood, and leaving to stay at shelter.
 - 1. These instances impact our data.
 - 2. Communication/education needed for shelters.
 - 3. Support needed for individuals and short-term funds needed for hoteling.

- 6. Ashely to create flyer and/or social media post to solicit care kits for the night of the PIT. Agencies to share.
