Oakland County Outcomes Committee Meeting Minutes

February 13, 2023

Group is looking at revamping/expanding the Outcomes committee to be charged with a wider range of community data and outcomes. Group discussed what objectives and community needs to focus on in addition to outcomes data for funders, PIT & HIC.

Group reviewed [Outcomes Committee Framework](#): data quality, policies, procedures, & goal of committee.

Objective:

The Alliance for Housing Outcomes Committee identifies, measures, and analyzes data to help inform public policy and improve community outcomes in Oakland County.

Group discussion to identify strategic objectives, purpose, in addition to required review of data for funders, PIT & HIC:

- Broader community outcomes, find and target gaps, look for additional funding/support.
- Gaps analysis, reviewing other CoCs work in gaps analysis.
- Affordable housing briefs in the works with links to resources.
- Look at county-wide data for shelters or veteran specific data.
- Analysis between community and those served, identify gaps in racial equity, demographics (work with C4).
 - Still waiting on final outcomes analysis report from C4 to ID data, disparities, etc.
- Include those with lived experience in the CoC for employment and full integration.
 - How to achieve more integration?

- Out-Wayne has implemented a successful way of achieving this.
 - Jessica can provide contact from out-Wayne.
 - CoC meetings provide space for attendees to share and bridge knowledge gaps, provide feedback, gather interest with general community.
 - Engage variety of people in committees/subcommittees.
 - Specific Block Grant funding available for compensation.
 - How to get people to go to meetings?
 - Ways of marketing/messaging who we are.
 - Explain partnership to community to familiarize so folks become more comfortable to share.
- Emergency housing & afterhours services in effort to help outside of business hours.
 - Strategic funding and planning around community response.
 - Track how many are in need of afterhours services (from gap analysis).

Action Items:

- Research gap analysis and other CoC info.
- Jessica will provide out-Wayne contact.
- Follow up with C4.
- Housing briefs.
- Decide topic to be discussed at next meeting in March.
- Advocacy day in Lansing is March 15.
 - Lighthouse plans to have representative attend.
 - Youth providers participate in Dome Day in March.
 - MI Network for Youth sends out statewide statistics.
