

CHRONICALLY HOMELESS August 2019

Chronically Homeless is defined as an individual or family that is homeless and resides in a place not meant for human habitation, a safe haven, or in an emergency shelter, and has been homeless and residing in such a place for at least 1 year or on at least four separate occasions in the last 3 years. The statutory definition also requires that the individual or family has a head of household with a diagnosable substance use disorder, serious mental illness, developmental disability, post-traumatic stress disorder, cognitive impairments resulting from a brain injury, or chronic physical illness or disability.

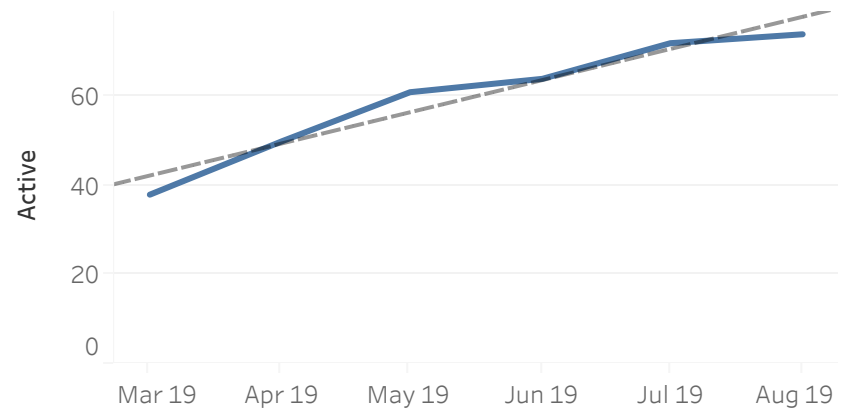
Housing Prioritization Registry

The Alliance for Housing established a centralized housing registry to provide equitable and consistent access to all potential program participants seeking permanent supportive housing in our local community. Referrals are made to the registry based on self-reported demographic, homeless history, and disability information. In accordance with guidance from HUD, the community will prioritize at least all available beds to chronically homeless individuals and households available from turnover. In situations where housing can be made available to a potential program participant that is not chronically homeless, the group will consider the person with the most need who meets the eligibility for the available slot of PSH.
